REQUIREMENTS

- ♦ 17 years of age at time of enrollment
- ♦ Must be able to speak, read, and write English
- ♦ All students subject to criminal background check
- ♦ All students will provide documentation of a physical exam prior to clinical/field phase of course
- ♦ Attendance at a **Mandatory EMS program orientation session[^]** prior to start date
- ♦ All fees must be paid **PRIOR** to February 6th.
- ♦ *If being paid by a third party, an **official letter of intent to pay** by authorized third party representative is required prior to start of class.*
