The Walk-In Clinic will be staffed by qualified, licensed physicians and/or nurse practitioners whose priority is caring for you. The Walk-In Clinic will offer weekend hours on a first come, first served basis.

To ensure a smooth continuum of care, patients' medical care records are stored on a shared medical record system used by both Clarke County Hospital and UnityPoint Health Affiliates. This also allows a patient access to their exam information on MyUnityPoint charts.

Weekend Walk-In Clinic

We understand that family illnesses and injuries don't always occur during regular business hours. For this reason, Clarke County Hospital is pleased to offer the Clarke County Hospital Walk-In Clinic, a weekend only clinic designed for non-emergency medical care. The Walk-In Clinic is designed to be a convenient alternative when your regular provider is not available for non-emergency medical care needs.

Clarke County Hospital's Walk-In Clinic is located inside the hospital's existing Specialty Clinic space. On weekends, patients will access the new clinic through the hospital's main entrance and lobby from 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM.



Clarke County Hospital's Walk-In Clinic will provide non-emergent care and a lower cost alternative than Emergency Department visits. Payment for co-pays and services not covered by insurance are due at time of visit.

What conditions can be treated?

Below is a list of common conditions typically seen, but exams are not limited to:

- Colds
- Coughs
- Cuts
- Earaches
- Fevers
- Flu
- Simple Fractures
- Infections
- Sore throats
- Sprains
- Urinary Tract Infections
- Yeast Infections

Can I still make an appointment?

For your convenience, we will be seeing patients on a first come, first served basis, therefore, appointments will not be scheduled for the Weekend Walk-In Clinic.

Does "Walk-In" mean that I will be seen right away?

We know that your time is valuable. We will make every effort to make your clinic visit as efficient as possible. Wait times will depend on the number of patients at any given time.

What about more complicated problems that need urgent attention?

The Clarke County Hospital Walk-In Clinic will be open on weekends, both Saturday and Sunday from 10 AM - 5 PM for non-emergent care. In the case of life threatening medical issues or situations, please continue to utilize Clarke County Hospital's Emergency Care, open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
