

2020 Housing Assistance Opportunity - City of Osceola

The City of Osceola is exploring a federal housing grant program that could benefit homeowners in Osceola by providing grant money to repair house exteriors. The program is described below.

Exterior Improvements Program – This program provides forgivable loans to homeowners who meet federal income requirements and need to fix up the outside of their homes. Work may include new siding, windows, doors, roof, foundation, etc. This program is designed to modernize the exteriors of homes for people that cannot afford to do so without the assistance. The income limits to qualify for the program are shown in the figure below.

There is no cost to apply and the program may only cost you about \$17 to participate in the program **if** the grant is awarded. Up to about \$30,000 in repairs are possible from the grant.
